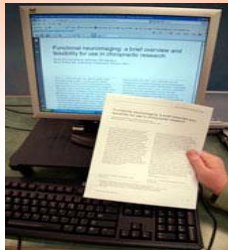


# ICL Highlights

**Consider subscribing** to print or online journals. Subscriptions for individuals are reasonably priced.

or

**Contact a library**, at your alma mater, or in your local region. See **About Us/CLC Member Libraries**

Each library sets its own fees for document delivery.

Additional copyright fees may apply. Ask your librarian for details.

or

**Order online articles from the publisher.** Some publishers of online journals do not permit libraries to deliver electronic documents such as PDF files.
